# JT Moore Middle School Cell Phone Policy for the 2025-2026 School Year

#### Purpose:

To create a focused and distraction-free learning environment while still allowing students to possess cell phones for safety and communication purposes outside of school hours.

### **Policy Guidelines:**

- 1. Possession of Cell Phones:
- Students are allowed to possess cell phones while on campus.

# 2. Phone Usage:

- All cell phones must be \*\*turned off\*\* upon arrival at school.
- Phones may be \*\*turned on\*\* only at dismissal when students leave the building.
- Cell phones are \*\*not permitted\*\* for use on school buses.

### 3. Confiscation Policy:

- Any student found using their cell phone during school hours will have their phone \*confiscated\*\*.
- Confiscated phones will be securely stored in the office and can be picked up by a parent or guardian after school.

#### 4. Smart Watches:

- Students are not permitted to use smart watches for receiving texts or phone calls while at school

#### 5. Communication with Parents:

- Parents are \*\*requested not to\*\* text or call their students on their cell phones or smart watches during school hours.
- For urgent communication, please contact the school office, and staff will ensure that your message reaches your student.

# Consequences for Policy Violations:

- Students who do not adhere to this policy will face disciplinary actions, which may include additional confiscation periods or further consequences as determined by school administration.
